

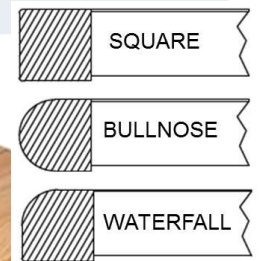

Butcher Block v. Plank

Butcher Block	Plank
Face-glued to make a harder surface (edge grain showing)	Face grain showing to make a lovely appearance
Hard enough surface to use as a work surface (prep, cooking, cutting, etc)	Softer surface designed as attractive serving or dining table
Less likely to check or split due to temperature conditions	Requires more temperature controlled climate for best maintenance
Harder surface is more difficult to stain evenly	Will stain more evenly because softer side is face up for a lovely appearance
Available with 1 ½” thickness only	Available in choice of economy 1” thickness or standard 1 ½” thickness
Lead time: Approximately 2 weeks	Lead time: 3 – 4 weeks



Please note, wood tables will occasionally warp due to the natural moisture within. We recommend using solid wood table tops in cool room settings (72 degrees) with a relative humidity of about 50-55%. Proper air circulation in the room is also recommended. Any sudden changes in temperature or humidity can affect the table top, so change your thermostat settings gradually as the seasons change. Do not use vinyl table cloths and/or glass tops on your tables in order to prevent warping. Excessive heat and dryness may cause cracking and splitting, so avoid extremely hot plates. Wipe up any excessive water immediately.
